In order to investigate crime and prepare for trial, Mr. Finkel worked closely with local law enforcement, as well as Federal agencies such as the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, and the Department of Homeland Security. Though obtaining many guilty verdicts and prevailing at trial against some of the county's most heinous gang members, Mr. Finkel also worked within the community to help troubled youths enroll in college.

Mr. Finkel was a Dean's List student at Syracuse University, graduating cum laude with a Bachelor of Science degree in Public Relations and a minor in Political Science. He earned his juris doctorate from Brooklyn Law School with an academic achievement scholarship. During law school, Mr. Finkel appeared in Kings County, New York Criminal Court as a student Assistant District Attorney, was a judicial intern for a New York State Supreme Court justice, and served as a law clerk for the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia. Mr. Finkel is a member of the Florida and New York Bars, and is admitted to practice in all Florida State courts, New York State courts, and the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida.
